



Next Steps - Growing On Sunflowers Outside in Soil

Place your sunflower seeds on a warm, sunny windowsill and keep well watered.

Once you can see 2 sets of leaves, take seedlings outside and dig a hole where you want your seedlings to grow. Allow 10" between each seedling planting.

Place the seedlings in carefully and cover them it up with soil. Don't forget to water the seedlings in gently and protect young shoots from slugs.

You may like to protect the seedlings by cutting the top off an empty plastic bottle and placing it over your seedlings.
